



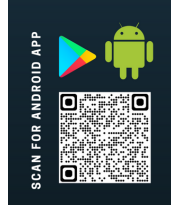
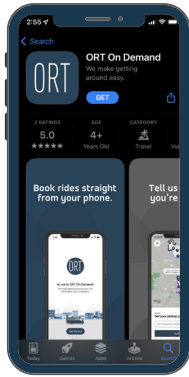

FIXED ROUTES \$0.00

A bus fixed route is a specific path that a bus follows when it travels around town. This route is "fixed," which means it doesn't change very often. People can look at a map or a schedule to find out where the bus goes and when it will arrive at different stops along the route.

ON-DEMAND \$0.00

An on-demand transit zone is a specific area where people can use a special kind of transportation service. Instead of following a fixed route like a regular bus, this transportation service will pick people up from wherever they are in the zone and take them where they want to go.

RIDING WITH ...

Baggage – ordinary hand baggage and packages or articles that can be carried without inconvenience to other passengers and can be carried in one trip on or off the bus.

Children – children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult or other caregiver. Babies and toddlers must be taken out of strollers or carriages and placed either on the adult/care-giver's lap or safely in the adjoining seat. Car seats are not a requirement on public transit.

Carriages and Strollers – baby carriages or strollers may be carried on board only when folded and do not block the aisles.

Carts – personal shopping carts may be carried on board so long as they do not block the aisle.

Walk aids and stand-up walkers – it is preferred that walkers be folded so as not to interfere with the free use of the aisles.

Service Animals – animals trained to provide assistance to an individual are considered service animals. Service animals perform tasks to help a person with disabilities live independently. Service animals must always be under control of the animal owner, and not be allowed to block the aisle or sit on the seats of the bus.

Pets – pets are allowed on the bus if they are under the control of the owner and in an approved animal carrier that is leak proof.

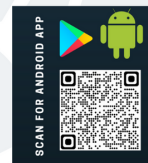
